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The Respiratory Department sees patients with chest related disease/illness the most common being asthma/COPD along side lung cancer, TB, and the investigation of symptoms such as coughs and shortness of breath.

They also see patients with sleep related breathing disorders such as sleep apnoea, and have a pulmonary function lab for a range of breathing tests that patients may require to help to determine a diagnosis.

There is also a dedicated respiratory physiotherapist assisting patients with a full range of chest conditions.

They are based predominantly in the outpatients department at the RBH with clinics also at Bracknell Healthspace and at West Berkshire Community Hospital.

During the talk there will be an opportunity for Q&A over Refreshments.

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
