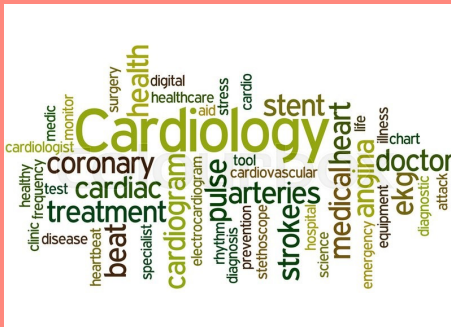

- The Cardiology Department at the RBH provides a combination of inpatient work, a large outpatient service offering cardiac investigations and invasive procedures, for both elective and emergency patients. Cardiac rehabilitation is provided by a clinical nurse specialist team, as well as the ambulatory heart failure lounge.
- The department runs a primary percutaneous coronary intervention (PCI) service 24 hours a day, seven days a week.
- The department has a commitment and passion for what they do, and believe that this is reflected in the staff and the service being delivered.
